The 16U and 14U leagues are a tournament/league format where teams will be reseeded for future events based on previous results; however, each day is a separate full tournament with its own winner. Each date will be guaranteed 3-6 matches. Next year, we are looking to expand to 24 teams for each age division each date. Help spread the word.
